#### Caretaker & Keyholder

At present we have an Acting Caretaker. The post is available as a permanent part-time contract to someone who is self-employed, and the basic duties are:

- To ensure that the Hall is unlocked, cleaned, prepared and ready for bookings, and secured afterwards.
- To act as nominated keyholder to open the Hall for access by those who occasionally need it without a formal booking for example, meter readers.
- To keep an eye on the building, and report to the Committee any maintenance work required.

Remuneration will be made monthly, and is pro rata to the number of bookings, so will vary from month to month.
