They will be remotely judged, and all the entries and results will be available on the Show website from 0900 on August 22nd.

So the classes that we think will work are on the next couple of pages, and we would love you to enter into the spirit of the virtual Show by sending in your entries by email to moorshow@moorsholmmemorialhall.org.uk by Monday August 10th. Give the name and class (and maybe a caption) in an accompanying email. The photography classes are straightforward — for the others please submit either a photograph or a scan/PDF file. We're making this up a bit as we go along, so if you have any problems, or need advice, please email me at the same address and I'll try to sort things out.

There are no entry fees, so we can't give prize money this year, but prize cards will be given, delivered to your door. Trophies will not be awarded either, and to avoid contact and sanitation problems we ask last year's winners to hold on to their trophies until 2021.

Then just sit back and mark your calendar with August 22nd, when from 0900 you can visit moorsholmmemorialhall.org.uk, click the 'Moorsholm Show' button on the left and there will be all the Show entries for you to enjoy. I'm afraid, though, that you may have to supply your own home-baking refreshments, sports and dog show!

Remember... The Show Must Go On(line)!... but if the situation changes, we'll try and do some (socially distanced) event such as a coffee morning or snack lunch to mark the day. If so, watch out for posters and another flier.

Because of the Covid-19 restrictions, it wasn't possible to hold the regular Committee meetings at which the draws are usually made, so instead (once restrictions were slightly eased in June) six of the Committee met on the lawn at Hazletree Farm, and (observing social distancing and hygiene rules) made the draws for March to May. The June, July and August draws will be announced on Show day.

RULES FOR THE SHOW

- 1. All entries are to be the property of the exhibitor, and to have been produced within the last two years (except where otherwise stated in the schedule).
- 2. Entries will close at Noon on Monday August 10th. To enable judging to start remotely, NO entries will be taken after this time.
- 3. Ages, for the children's classes, will be taken as on Show Day.
- 4. Exhibitors breaking any rule will (if detected) forfeit all prizes that they win. All objections must be made to the Secretary in writing before 4.30pm on the Show day, with a deposit of £2.00. If the objection is not proved, the deposit goes to the Hall funds. The decision of the Committee is final, and is subject to no appeal at law.
- 5. The Judge's decision is final.
- 6. All exhibits shall be submitted at the risk of the exhibitors, and the Hall Committee shall not be liable for any compensation for any loss, damage or injury from any cause whatsoever. Should the Show not be held for any reason, no exhibitor shall have any claim on the Show Committee.
- 7. When the entries in a class consist of only one specimen, it shall not be entitled to a prize, unless deemed worthy by the Judges. Likewise the 2nd and 3rd prizes if there are less than 4 entries.

Data Protection Policy

Entries for Moorsholm Show are processed and stored electronically. Details requested are Name and Surname, Age (if a Child), Email Address and classes entered. Details are used for recording the Show results and subsequent publishing of the results on the Show website, and entries are made on this understanding. No other use is made of the data, and it will not be passed on to any third party. Apart from the results, data will not be kept longer than 5 years.
