- 1. All entries are to be the property of the exhibitor, and to have been produced within the last two years (except where otherwise stated in the schedule).
- 2. Entries will close at Noon on Monday August 16th. To enable judging to start remotely, NO entries will be taken after this time.
- 3. Ages, for the children's classes, will be taken as on Show Day.
- 4. Exhibitors breaking any rule will (if detected) forfeit all prizes that they win. All objections must be made to the Secretary in writing before 4.30pm on the Show day, with a deposit of £2.00. If the objection is not proved, the deposit goes to the Hall funds. The decision of the Committee is final, and is subject to no appeal at law.
- 5. The Judge's decision is final.
- 6. All exhibits shall be submitted at the risk of the exhibitors, and the Hall Committee shall not be liable for any compensation for any loss, damage or injury from any cause whatsoever. Should the Show not be held for any reason, no exhibitor shall have any claim on the Show Committee.
- 7. When the entries in a class consist of only one specimen, it shall not be entitled to a prize, unless deemed worthy by the Judges. Likewise the 2nd and 3rd prizes if there are less than 4 entries.

Data Protection Policy

Entries for Moorsholm Show are processed and stored electronically. Details requested are Name and Sumame, Age (if a Child), Email Address and classes entered. Details are used for recording the Show results and subsequent publishing of the results on the Show website, and entries are made on this understanding. No other use is made of the data, and it will not be passed on to any third party. Apart from the results, data will not be kept longer than 5 years.
